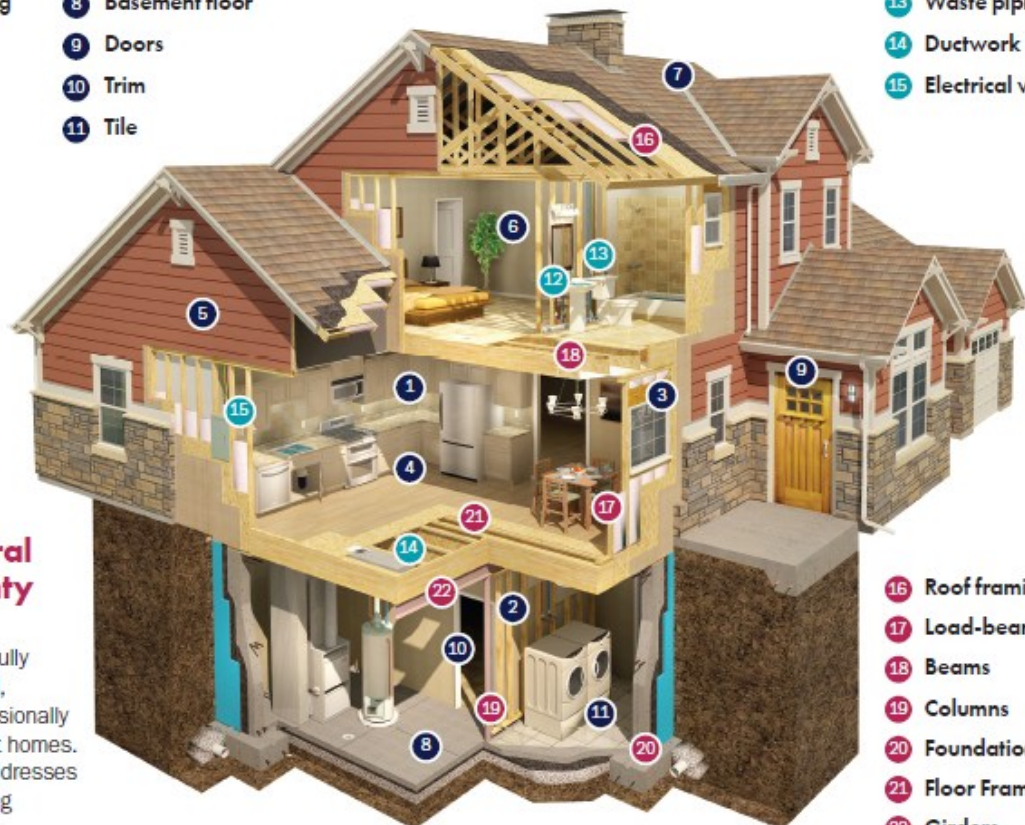

This subflooring has water channels built in to drain water quickly when it rains during the framing phase. We also nail, glue, and screw down each subfloor panel, sand the edges, and also screw down each interior wall to prevent floor and wall squeaking. We also use **REAL WOOD** dimensional lumber in the construction of the entire home including floor systems (no engineered floor systems that are bouncy), adding to the stability and soundness of our homes.
